HISTORY

An elderly couple in San Bruno, California originally owned this Rambler Classic. When I purchased this automobile from the couple in February of 1998, it had only 26,800 original miles on it. After confronting many years of dirt and out-of-adjustments, the automobile rambles as smooth and as quiet as new. Everything works from the vacuum operated wipers to the vacuum tube radio. And as for the clock, it was working until I tried to clean it... DOH!
